If you are arriving via car and have a GPS system in the car or on your phone, please use 280 Brookline Dr, Purlar NC for the location. **PLEASE DOUBLE CHECK YOUR GPS WITH THE FOLLOWING DIRECTIONS AS SOME GPS UNITS (INCLUDING PHONES) WILL TAKE YOU TO THE WRONG LOCATION** If you do not have a GPS device, you can find us by the following directions:

From Wilkesboro (coming from the East):

Once you are through Wilkesboro look for Lowe's Home Improvement on the left

- Head West on US-421 (Travel approximately 10.9 miles from Lowes)
- Turn Right onto Pumpkin Run Rd. (Travel 1.4 miles)
- Turn Right onto Buck Mountain Road

From Boone / West Jefferson (coming from the West):

- Head southeast on US-421 S (from the intersection of 421 and 221 you will travel approximately 8.5 miles)
- Turn Left onto Pumpkin Run Rd (travel 1.4 miles)
- Turn Right onto Buck Mountain Road

ONCE YOU ARE AT BUCK MOUNTAIN

Buck Mountain is a gated community. This provides our guests with many amenities such as maintained roads and security during their stay. Because of this, you will need to use a gate code to enter. This code will be sent to our visitors before their stay due to the fact that the code changes at the expiration of your stay. You will not need the code to exit the neighborhood. When you arrive at the key code shed, stay to the right and the keypad will be accessible to the driver. Please make sure you put “#” in front of the number when you type it in. Once the gate opens, it will stay open long enough for ONE car. **DO NOT FOLLOW CARS THROUGH THE GATE AS IT MAY RESULT IN DAMAGE TO YOUR VEHICLE.**

DIRECTIONS TO THE HOUSE FROM THE GATE

From the gate, take Buck Mountain Rd. approximately 1.2 miles. There are mile marker signs on the left side of the road.



Just past the 1.1 mile marker, you will come to an intersection. If you follow the yellow line (turning to the far left), this will turn into Staghorn Rd.



Follow Staghorn Rd. for almost 1.2 miles. Just BEFORE the 1.2 mile marker, you will see a gravel road on the left. This is Brookline Dr.



You will travel on Brookline (the gravel drive) for about 0.2 miles. You will see the mailbox on the left and you will turn to the right. The driveway will be on the right and is on a hill. It will help to not stop on the driveway because of the hill.



PARKING

Parking is provided on site for 2 cars. Please make sure cars are parked beside the external stairs or directly in front of the house. ALL CARS SHOULD REMAIN ON THE GRAVELED AREA. If you have additional parking requirements, please notify us before your arrival. In the event of inclement weather, you may park on the right-hand shoulder of Brookline before reaching the mailbox.

WELCOME TO THE CABIN

We have placed the key lock box on the back side of the porch pole that has the address of the house on it (look for "280" on the pole). The combination will be sent via message before your stay. This is for your safety as we change the combination on a regular basis. The key inside will unlock the upstairs and downstairs locks.

DEPARTURE INFORMATION

CHECK-OUT TIME

Check-out time is strictly 11 am. Should you require a later check-out we will do our best but you need to let us know beforehand. If we have guests arriving that day it will be almost impossible to offer a late check-out due to the cleaners needing to prepare for those guests.

CHECK-OUT PROCESS

When you leave, please ensure the following simple tasks are done:

- ensure the air-conditioning is set to 85F or the heater is set to 60F
- remove trash from the cabin and take to the community facility. Leaving the neighborhood, this will be on your left about 1 mile after getting back on the paved road. [Google Map Link](#)
- run the dishwasher (dishwashing detergent is under the kitchen sink)
- If you used the hot tub, please set it to "Ecn" mode ([see hot tub quickstart for instructions](#)), set temperature to 80F, and make sure the cover is on and latched
- lock the house
- leave the key in the lock box and lock it (change the combination number)

We hope you had a wonderful visit and wish you safe travels back home. We'd love to see you again soon!

CLEANING

You will find the house clean on arrival but please let us know if you are not satisfied. For stays of 1 week, there is no cleaning service. After you depart our cleaners will perform that for the next guest. Please remove all personal belongings and dispose of trash when you check out.

GETTING YOURSELF ORIENTED

OVERVIEW OF THE AREA

Misty Mountain Retreat is located in a gated community with easy access to Wilkesboro, Boone and Blowing Rock and close to the Blue Ridge Parkway. A short 15-minute drive on 421 headed East will get you to Wilkesboro. In Wilkesboro, you will find almost everything you could need as far as [grocery stores](#), [restaurants](#), and entertainment. If you travel 20 minutes West on 421, you will arrive in Boone NC where you can find an abundance of outdoor activities as well as another large selection of restaurants, shopping, and entertainment.

SUGGESTIONS IF YOU ARRIVE EARLY

Many guests will arrive before the designated check-in time. The good news is that there is plenty to do. We often suggest that guests visit the [grocery](#) store and pick up any small items you may need. That will give you more time to relax once you've checked in! There are also a [few good restaurants](#) for lunch so why not relax and enjoy some of the local food! You may also want to drive up to Staghorn Falls and enjoy the view (Directions: Rather than turning on Brookline Dr. to go to the cabin, continue on Staghorn Dr. for approximately .8 miles)



ABOUT THE ACCOMMODATIONS

APPLIANCE INSTRUCTIONS / INFORMATION

AIR CONDITIONING

Our home has the benefit of air conditioning. You will find a panel on the wall in the family room. Please ensure that all windows and outside doors are closed while the AC is running to ensure it operates to maximum efficiency. We recommend a setting of 76F which we find keeps the place sufficiently cool.

CEILING FANS

Our home is equipped with ceiling fans to help keep you cool. Each fan is operated via a switch on the wall.

CENTRAL HEATING

Our home has a central heating system. You will find a panel on the wall in the family room. We recommend a setting of 72F which we find keeps the place sufficiently warm.

FIREPLACE

Our home has a working gas fireplace. Please take extra care when using the fireplace. Especially important is to ensure that the fire is turned off before you head to bed. The fireplace will get extremely hot. If you have children, please do not operate the fireplace if they will be in the house.

KITCHEN EQUIPMENT

All manuals for the electrical equipment and appliances are in the top left cabinet above the refrigerator.

The Dishwasher:

We provide a supply of tablets - These can be found under the kitchen sink. You will need to insert one into the flip box container on the inside of the dishwasher door. Then press the program button of your choice - there are a few settings which are obvious - then press the start button.

The Fridge/freezer:

You should not need to adjust any settings. If you run into any difficulties (e.g. it's not cooling efficiently) please let us know.

The Oven:

Please be aware that if you have children, the controls for the oven and stove are easily accessible to them.

Kitchen cookware

The cabin is equipped with Granitestone cookware. Here are some cooking tips from the manufacturer:

- Always use medium heat. Medium heat gives the best flavor and never burns your food.
- High-heat cooking may be used when you are searing steaks or any meat dishes.
- For the best eggs you have ever made, set heat to medium and cook with little or no oil.
- Allow pan to heat for a minute before adding in the eggs (or any food item).
- While the Granitestone pan is scratch-proof, we recommend you do not use sharp knives on the pan.
- A regular sponge with soap and water is all you'll need for easy clean up. NEVER clean the Granitestone Pan using a metal scrub pad.

KITCHEN STAPLES

A variety of kitchen staples are available for guest use. If you use the last of an item, please replace it or let the homeowner know. Please remove all perishable food from the home when you check out.

LAUNDRY APPLIANCES

We have a washer and separate dryer located in the basement. There is a supply of detergent for your use. To operate the machines, simply select the program you want, place the detergent in the tray, close the door, and hit start. If in any doubt there are instructions next to the machines.

ENJOYING YOUR TIME INSIDE

BOARD GAMES / PLAYING CARDS

Please enjoy the selection of games, cards and books you will find under the family room TV and in the side table behind the couch. We ask that when you are done, please clean these things up and put them back so that others can enjoy them as well.

TELEVISION / DVD SYSTEM

All TV's are smart with installed apps. If you have Netflix, Amazon Prime Video or other subscriptions you will be able to login to access your accounts. Below the family room TV, you will find a DVD player as well as a small selection of movies. Please feel free to curl up on the couch and watch one. To access the DVD player, select "Input" on the black TV remote and navigate to "DVD Player".

The bedroom TVs have digital antenna connections for live TV. To access live TV, use the directional button on the remote control and scroll to the right to "Live". If you have a subscription please feel free to login to your account. Don't forget to log out before you leave! We cannot be responsible for charges accrued by the next guests on your account.

ENJOYING YOUR TIME OUTSIDE

FISHING EQUIPMENT

All children under the age of 18 should be accompanied by an adult anytime they are around the water. Please feel free to use the fishing equipment found in the basement, however, all equipment should be returned to the proper location in good working order.

CHAIRS / TABLES

The deck chairs should remain on the deck and not placed close to the stairs for any reason.

GRILL / BBQ

Grilling out on the deck is one of our favorite things to do for dinner. If you would like to use the grill, you will need to turn the propane on using the valve on the tank. Then the second burner from the left should be used to light the grill. Simply turn the gas on using the knob and push the black ignite button. Please do not move the grill under the porch as this could be a fire hazard. Once you have finished cooking, the propane should be turned off.

HOT TUB / JACUZZI

We have an outdoor hot tub available for your use. Please note that this will be cold on your arrival and does take a few hours to heat to the optimal temperature. As such, if you wish to use it, please ensure you turn it on by the instructions provided in the hot tub instructions found [by following this link](#).

- When you have finished using it please turn it to the economy mode for efficiency.
- Please also pay special attention to the safety rules which are located beside the tub.
- All children under the age of 18 must be accompanied by an adult while using the hot tub at all times.
- **THE COVER SHOULD BE ON THE HOT TUB ANY TIME IT IS NOT IN USE** and latched for safety and power saving.
- **NO GLASS IS ALLOWED IN OR AROUND THE HOT TUB**

OTHER USEFUL INFORMATION

BREAKAGES

We understand that sometimes accidents happen! Should you break anything please let us know immediately - if it's minor we usually won't charge. If it's a larger issue (e.g. the TV screen) we would like to agree to the cost with you before you leave to avoid any issues later. Thank you!

BED LINEN / TOWELS

Extra bed linens and towels can be found in the bedroom closet closest to the restroom.

GARBAGE DISPOSAL & RECYCLING

If you need to remove waste from the house, the community garbage facility is just up Staghorn Rd. near the intersection with Buck Mountain Road on the left as you are leaving the neighborhood (this is about 1.1 miles from Brookline Dr.). You may place household trash in the compactor.

WHAT TO DO IN CASE OF A POWER OUTAGE

The breaker box is located downstairs beside the washer and dryer. If the power outage is a result of a breaker tripping, you can find the tripped breaker by visually inspecting each breaker. The tripped breaker will be slightly off set from the others. To reset, pull the breaker to the off position and then pull it back to the on position.

If the power outage encompasses the entire house, please contact BlueRidge Energy at 800-451-5474. Tell them the address (280 Brookline Dr., Purlear) and that the power has gone out. They are very quick to respond.

QUIET TIMES

While the cabin is secluded and relatively private, we want to be respectful of our neighbors. Please keep noise to a minimum between 9:00 PM – 7:00 AM.

SMOKING POLICY

Misty Mountain Retreat is a non-smoking cabin.

RULES & REGULATIONS

COMPLEX / SUBDIVISION RULES

Misty Mountain Retreat is in the gated mountain community of Buck Mountain. This is a private neighbourhood for residents and guests. Please observe all posted speed limits. While you are visiting, you are welcome to enjoy the facilities such as Staghorn falls, catch and release fishing in the community stocked pond, hike some of our amazing trails or just kick back and relax at one of the picnic tables. While you are enjoying yourselves, please help us keep the neighborhood pristine by cleaning up any trash you may bring in with you.

PETS

We are pet lovers and welcome you and your pet to our pet-friendly cabin.

General Pet Rules

We ask that you please respect the comfort and safety of other guests/neighbors, both during and after your stay. Please leave our home as it was when you arrived.

- Pets must be housebroken.
- Please clean up after your dog, both in public areas and in the yard of your rental property. Please use proper disposal item provided in the basket on the pantry floor, bags and garbage can.
- Please do not allow your dog to bark excessively or to roam onto neighboring property.
- Dog nails should be trimmed as to not damage pinewood floors
- All pets must be up to date on rabies vaccinations.
- Due to variable weather of N.C. all pets must be on flea and tick prevention with treatment at least 3 days prior to arrival.
- N.C. and our neighborhood HOA has a leash law requiring all pets to be on a leash when outdoors.
- Pets may not exceed 70 pounds without the pre-approval of the homeowner.
- Our furniture and beds are for our human guests. Please provide proper bedding and comfort for your pet.
- Even the best behaved pet may be loud or destructive if left unattended in unfamiliar places. You are welcome to bring a crate for your pet.

- Do not leave your pet unattended on the balcony.
- Please report any unforeseen accidents to the homeowner.
- Please do your best to clean and dry your pet after walking. A small supply of old towels are available as needed.
- Do not allow animals in the hot tub.

SAFETY INFORMATION

EMERGENCY EXIT INSTRUCTIONS

For your safety, Buck Mountain offers a fire escape route just North of the cabin. This road is only used during emergency situations such as a forest fire or ambulance egress. To access this road from the cabin, follow Brookline Dr. (the gravel road) out to the paved road (Staghorn Rd.). Take a LEFT on Staghorn Rd. the emergency exit will be about .2 miles on the right.

EMERGENCY PHONE NUMBERS

For emergency services please immediately call the proper authorities. Do not delay if you feel an emergency situation has arisen.

LOCATION OF FIRE EXTINGUISHER

The fire extinguisher can be found mounted to the pantry door in the kitchen. To operate, remove the fire extinguisher from the mount, pull the safety pin, point in the direction of the fire and squeeze the handle. If the fire extinguisher is used, call the fire department immediately even if you believe the fire is extinguished. Notify the homeowners after calling 911.

LOCATION OF GAS SHUT-OFF VALVE

There are two gas shut off valves for the fireplace (the fireplace is the only appliance that uses gas). The first is found behind the fireplace. It has a red handle and will need to be turned perpendicular to the gas line (see picture). The second shut off can be found outside on the main propane tank. This can be turned off by twisting the valve clock wise until it stops turning.

SMOKE & CARBON MONOXIDE DETECTORS

Our cabin is equipped with smoke and carbon monoxide detectors. The smoke detectors are outside and inside of each bedroom. The carbon monoxide detector is located adjacent to the basement stairs. In the event of a power outage, the devices have battery back-ups. If this fails, the detector will indicate this with timed beeps. If you need to replace a battery in a detector, extra ones can be found inside the night stands of each bedroom.

Misty Mountain Retreat is a non-smoking cabin.

HOT TUB QUICKSTART

Quick Start:

Initial Startup

- 1) Press the "MODE" and "HEAT" button at the same time and then press the "MODE" button once. This changes the mode between Standard (Std), Economy (Ecn), and Sleep (Slp).
- 2) Repeat step 1 until the display is "Std"
- 3) Set the temperature using the "HEAT" or "COOL" buttons.
- 4) Use the "JETS" button to turn the jets on or off.
- 5) Use the "LIGHTS" button to set the pattern and color of the LEDs (see below)

Shutdown after use (not checking out)

- 1) Press the "MODE" and "HEAT" button at the same time and then press the "MODE" button once. This changes the mode between Standard (Std), Economy (Ecn), and Sleep (Slp).
- 2) Repeat step 1 until the display is "Ecn"
- 3) Set the temperature to 95F.

Shutdown (checking out)

- 1) Press the "MODE" and "HEAT" button at the same time and then press the "MODE" button once. This changes the mode between Standard (Std), Economy (Ecn), and Sleep (Slp).
- 2) Repeat step 1 until the display is "Ecn"
- 3) Set the temperature to 80F.

LED Lights

Press the "Light" button to turn the LED lights on and off. To toggle between all the LED color options, press the light button on, then off, then wait about 1 second and turn on again. A different color option will appear*. The LED light will turn off automatically after 1 hour.

Color options:

Each time the light is turned on and off it will advance according to the following sequence:

1. Color wheel: changes quickly.	7. Solid Color: Blue
2. Color fade: Colors fades.	8. Solid Color: Yellow
3. Random Color Change: Random colors.	9. Solid Color: Indigo
4. Spectrum fade: Colors fades.	10. Solid Color: Orange
5. Solid Color: Red	11. Solid Color: Violet
6. Solid Color: Green	12. Solid Color: White (15 minute shut off)

Bedroom Remote Guide

To start first press the power button located at the top right of the remote.

1. Once at the home menu for the TV you will see a number of tabs located at the top of the TV. To navigate these tabs use the black circle located at the center of the remote.
2. To watch live TV, Scroll right until you are at the tab name “Live”. To find all available channels scroll down to the row named “Antenna Channels”, or to find recently watched channels scroll up until located at the row named “Recent Channels”.
 - a. To watch/use apps downloaded onto the TV, scroll down to the row named “Your Apps & Channels”. Then scroll over to the left and click on “See All.” Then using the gray circle inside the black circle located in the center of the remote press once, then select the preferred game or app.
3. To use the voice activated helper “Alexa” press the top-most center button and hold until you state your problem or destination then release.
 - a. To exit or “back up” use the reverse arrow top-most left.
 - b. To control the volume use the + and – sign buttons located towards the bottom center of the remote.



Living Room Remote Guide

Turn on the TV using the power button on the black remote.

1. To watch live TV, use the input button on the remote and scroll over using the arrows towards the center of the remote.
2. To exit live TV and get to apps, use the “Input” button on the black remote and scroll over using the arrows on the black remote until it says “SmartCast” in white letters and follow directions under “3.” to locate apps.
3. To use any apps or play music downloaded onto the TV, scroll down using the arrows until you’re at the row named “Apps” and select your app using the arrows on the remote.
4. To change the volume on the TV use the “+ volume –” button on the lower left of the black remote.
5. To select items on the TV use the “ok” button in the center of the arrow buttons on the black remote.
6. To turn off the TV, use the power button on the black remote.

FIREPLACE

THE FIREPLACE SHOULD NEVER BE LEFT ON WHEN UNATTENDED!

- 1) Turn gas on using the red knob behind fireplace. To do this, turn the knob counter clockwise so that it is parallel to the gas line.

GAS OFF POSITION

- 2) Open the door on the bottom of the fireplace.
- 3) Press in and turn the knob labeled “pilot” counter clockwise so that the word “pilot” is aligned with the white line.
- 4) Press the pilot knob in for 5 seconds and then press the ignitor found just to the right of the pilot knob while still holding the pilot knob in.
- 5) Look for a flame on the right side of the logs inside the fire place.
 - a. If you see a flame, keep holding the pilot knob for 10 sec. then turn the pilot knob to the “on” position.
 - b. If you do not see flames repeat the process above. After 3 attempts, please turn the gas off behind the fireplace. You can retry in 15 minutes.

Once you have a pilot light:

- 1) Using the remote, press the “mode” key once or twice until you see “on”
- 2) To turn off, press the “mode” key until you see “off”
- 3) If you would like to set the temperature to automatically turn on and off, press the “mode” key until you see “Auto temp” and then use the arrows to set the desired temperature.

DO NOT LEAVE THE FIREPLACE ON UNATTENDED!
